Eleventh Supplementary Offering Document of UBL Fixed Return Fund II

Managed by UBL Fund Managers Limited (UBL Funds) an Asset Management Company registered with the Securities & Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP) and regulated under the Non-Banking Finance Companies (NBFC) Rules 2003 and NBFC & NE Regulations 2008.

The UBL Fixed Return Fund-II (the Fund/the Scheme/the Trust/the Unit Trust/UFRF) has been established through a Trust Deed (the Deed) under the Sindh Trust Act, 2020 entered into and between UBL Fund Managers Limited, the Management Company, Central Depository Company Limited, the Trustee and is authorized under the Non-Banking Finance Companies and Notified Entities Regulations, 2008 ("Regulations").

Objective of the 11th Supplementary Offering Document

UBL Funds is launching following Plans under UBL Fixed Return Fund via this supplementary Offering Document of UBL Fixed Return Fund - II (UFRF-II).

- i. UBL Fixed Return Plan – II (m)
- ii. UBL Fixed Return Plan – II (n)
- iii. UBL Fixed Return Plan – II (o)

Words and expressions used but not defined in this Supplemental shall have the same meanings as are assigned to them in the Offering Document of UBL Fixed Return Fund - II (UFRF- II).

1. The following sub clause 1.10.2 and 1.10.3 has been amended under clause 1.10 "Structure of Scheme" and read as follows;

- 1.10.2 The Fund shall offer various Investment Plans based on their structure of fixed maturity investing in the investable avenues as defined in the Offering Document of the Fund.
- 1.10.3 The duration of the Fund is perpetual; however, Investment Plans launched underline shall have a fixed maturity.

2. In this context I am directed to convey approval of the Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP) for the 11th Supplemental Offering Document of UBL Fixed Return Fund II for launch of

- a) UBL Fixed Return Plan -II (m)
- b) UBL Fixed Return Plan -II (n)
- c) UBL Fixed Return Plan -II (o)

in terms of Regulation 54(1) read with Regulation 44(8) of Non-Banking Finance Companies and Notified Entities Regulations 2008 (the 'Regulations') on the following conditions:

- I. The approval granted for 11th Supplemental Offering Document of the fund is valid for implementation within a period of one hundred and twenty (120) days from the date of issuance of approval letter within which the above-mentioned Plans shall be offered for subscription provided that there is no change in the approved documents or the approval has not been extended. In case of failure to offer for subscription within the aforesaid timeline, the supplemental offering document shall be resubmitted for review and approval;
- II. The Pre-IPO subscription in the plan being offered under the fund shall only be initiated once a definite date for IPO is announced, mentioned in OD and the amounts/investments received during the Pre-IPO period shall remain locked-in till the date of IPO of the Plan subject to a specific disclosure to Pre-IPO investors regarding the lock-in period;
- III. The Management Company shall not invest assets of the plan abroad unless it has obtained prior written approval of State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) and the Commission in this regard; where such investment shall be in line with the overall framework of authorized investment as prescribed for this category of collective investment scheme;



- IV. Contents of Supplemental Offering Document will not be altered/amended/deleted without prior written approval of the Commission except for adding reference of date(s) and No. of letter(s) approving the Document; wherever relevant;
- V. Approval of the Supplemental Offering Document will, in no way, absolve the Management Company of its obligations about contents of, or statements made in the Document;
- VI. The Management Company shall include approval of Board of Directors along with date in the Supplemental Offering Document;
- VII. The Management Company shall give at least a week to the prospective investors of the Plan for studying the Supplemental Offering Document;
- VIII. The Management Company shall ensure compliance with the prevailing requirements of law including NBFC Regulations and its constitutive document; and
- IX. The Management Company shall place the updated and consolidated constitutive document (with notes referring to the supplemental constitutive document highlighting the change made in the original document/ clauses), along with the original and supplemental/restated constitutive documents separately on its website. The updated constitutive documents shall be placed immediately or after completion of the duration of the notice period, as the case may be. Furthermore, the updated constitutive documents shall clearly specify the last date of update i.e. "XYZ fund updated up to DD/MM/YY".
- X. The subscription period shall be of maximum 60 days.
- XI. The expression "Allocation Plan" shall be replaced with the expression "Investment Plan" and due amendments in the definition clause shall be added ("Investment Plan shall be the Allocation Plan as defined in the OD").
- XII. All the investors at time of investment shall clearly be communicated about the expiry date of Subscription Period and the Maturity date of the Plan.
